National DeafBlind Registry: Every year, the National Center on DeafBlindness (NCDB) collaborates with state DeafBlind Projects, to publish the National DeafBlind Child Count or Registry.

The map above shows the location of Educational Service Districts (ESDs) in Washington state. The table at right lists total children by age group in each ESD (December 2023). NCDB publishes the finalized count, and state DeafBlind Projects use the data to plan technical assistance.
